- ☐ Pre-camp admin support: will involve helping out in the YDN office with compiling registration packets / name tags / materials and participant form tracking and coordination during July.
- ☐ Conflict Mediators: Adults skilled in youth conflict resolution to promote safe surroundings and guidance in resolving disputes without resorting to violence, verbal or physical.
- ☐ Event Set-up: support activities involved in setting up volunteer check-in, registration, meeting rooms, campus, directional signs and markings, snacks and beverages, water stations, etc.
- ☐ Registration Process: Day 1 (July 31) morning - support participant registration, greeters, check-in.
- ☐ Volunteer Check-in: will include support with set-up and early check-in for Day 1. As well as continued opportunities throughout the event based on volunteer check-in schedules, roles and responsibilities.

- ☐ Workshop/Block Hosts - Evaluations: will support participant check-in process, assist facilitation team as needed, hand-out, collect and transcribe evaluations for program blocks.

- ☐ Dorm Overnight Chaperones: small groups will support each other along with a team lead and be responsible for the safety of participants housed in dorms. (tentative shifts 8pm-2am and 2am-8am - nights of July 31 and Aug 1)
- ☐ Dance/Celebration Day 2 -- Aug 1 - evening event
 - ☐ Set-up: will involve set-up tasks involved in evening activities and entertainment.
 - ☐ Activity Hosts: will support specific activities as needed.
 - ☐ Chaperones: will support the safety and wellbeing of youth during evening activities and entertainment.
 - ☐ Dance/Celebration Clean-up: will involve tasks related to cleanup of evening activities.
